THERAPY SERVICES

Offered at all four locations.
For children from birth to age 21.

Team-based, individualized therapy for acute, short-term issues to chronic, lifetime needs. Care provided by therapists who specialize in pediatrics. Services include evaluation, therapy programs, and training for assistive/adaptive equipment.

ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY

Evaluations and training services for children and adults for: assistive daily living aids; augmentative communication; classroom, home or work-related modifications; computer access/adaptations; environmental controls; independent living evaluations; positioning aids; orthotics & headpointers; and wheelchairs & seating. State of the art "Smart Suite" available for evaluation and training.

CHILDREN'S FEEDING PROGRAM Solutions. Served Daily.

Designed for children who have a medical condition that has affected their feeding and growth. Interdisciplinary services include behavioral and feeding therapy provided by Occupational and Speech/Language Therapists with special training in feeding issues. Treatment addresses medical, developmental, behavioral, oral motor and sensory feeding issues.

INFANT SERVICES/ EARLY INTERVENTION

Children's Hospital provides Early Intervention (Part C) Services for children from birth to 36 months of age from Chesterfield, Henrico and the City of Richmond. Children from these areas are eligible to receive an interdisciplinary evaluation at no cost to family. Part C services include occupational, physical and speech therapy, and service coordination.

MOTION ANALYSIS LAB

Computer technology, specialized monitoring equipment and analytical methods provide quantitative descriptions of motion for surgery or other treatment planning. Commonly provided evaluations include gait analysis and upper extremity analysis. Evaluations can be customized for needs of patient and/or referring physician or therapist.

NUTRITION SERVICES

Registered dietitians/nutritionists serve children and adolescents with complex medical issues or specific concerns. Services include medical nutrition therapy; nutrition screenings and counseling.

PSYCHOLOGY

Program staffed by licensed clinical psychologists who specialize in the psychological needs of children and adolescents related to medical, emotional and behavioral issues. Services include: individual & family therapy; psychological evaluations & therapy; psycho-educational evaluations; neuropsychological evaluations; and support groups.
