### CHILDREN'S FEEDING PROGRAM

Designed for children who have a medical condition that has affected their feeding and growth. Interdisciplinary team-based treatment addresses medical, developmental, behavioral, oral motor and sensory feeding issues as well as family education. Specific issues children face which indicate they are appropriate to refer for evaluation include: failure to thrive; food/drink refusal; food or swallowing phobias; food selectivity (by type, texture); inability to chew or swallow; mealtime behavior problems; recurrent gagging or vomiting; and tube-dependency.

### MUSCULAR DYSTROPHY

Program provides clinical services for children with neuromuscular diseases including: Friedreich's ataxia, muscular dystrophy, myasthenia gravis and spinal muscular atrophy. Care provided by specialists in Neurology, PM&R, Cardiology, Nursing, Physical Therapy, Educational Consultation, equipment needs, and health care coordination as needed.

### PHYSICAL MEDICINE & REHABILITATION (PM&R)

Programming focuses on treatment of physical/functional disorders with a goal of attaining full potential for improved quality of life. Designed to help children with a disability and/or loss of function in: physical activities, daily living activities, communication, social interaction skills, and/or cognition. Diagnostic categories include: brachial plexus injuries; brain injury, multiple trauma, deconditioning & myopathies following prolonged critical illness; myelodysplasia; neurologic disorders, including stroke and epilepsy; obesity; reflex sympathetic dystrophy (RSD); rheumatologic disorders; spinal cord injury; sports injury; and torticollis.

Multidisciplinary approach to treatment of spasticity and movement disorders in children. Team includes specialists from Orthopaedics, Neurology, Neurosurgery, PM&R, Physical Therapy, Nursing, Educational Consultation, equipment needs, and health care coordination as needed. Multidisciplinary approach allows for treatments including oral medications, local injections and orthopaedic surgery, as well as neurosurgical interventions such as intrathecal baclofen pump placement and selective dorsal rhizotomy. Program serves any child with a spasticity or movement disorder.
